By the time things were in full swing, an astonishing 93 people had filled the hall with chatter, laughter, and that unmistakable warm buzz of a proper community get-together.

Thanks to the generous support of Robinsons Cider and Ludlow Brewery, the bar was well stocked and spirits were high. Meanwhile, The Pizza Girls were working flat out to keep everyone fed, though even they couldn't quite keep up with the appetite of the crowd, running out of pizzas in just an hour and a half!

Not long after, a few of the more popular beers began to dwindle too, but thankfully there was still plenty of choice behind the bar, enough wines, beers, and cider to ensure no one went thirsty and the cheerful atmosphere carried on uninterrupted.

The hall hummed with conversation as old friends caught up, new connections were made, and neighbours shared stories and laughter. It was exactly what a village pub night should be, relaxed, welcoming, and full of good humour. When the "last orders" bell rang at 9pm, it was met with a collective groan, a sure sign of an evening well enjoyed.

The feedback since has been nothing but glowing, and it's clear that the night struck just the right note. Our second pub night is set for Saturday 15th August. If you missed this one then you won't want to miss the next!
